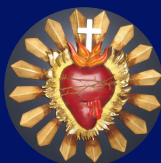

Iris Halter

Benefit Breakfast

On June 2, Iris Halter was admitted to the CHI Hospital in Dickinson after struggling with Norovirus. She was transferred by Emergency flight to the children's hospital in Fargo after not improving after multiple days. Once in Fargo, things continued to escalate and worsen. After multiple scans, tests, and blood work, the doctors suspected a couple of things. She was treated for Botulism and Guillain Barre Syndrome with special medication flown in from L.A., as well as being put on a breathing tube due to her respiratory failing. It was later confirmed it was Botulism, but a rare Type F that made her only the 28th person in the world to contract it which required another specialized antitoxin treatment. The doctors also decided to send off for emergency genetic testing to see what information that might yield. While dealing with Botulism, Iris was also diagnosed with a rare syndrome called Leigh Syndrome, which is a mitochondrial disease and LIPT1 deficiency. She requires specific supplements to help her body have a chance at fighting infection, illness, and stress as well as functioning and developing properly. She also had to get a G-tube placement to help deliver all her meds and feedings due to aspiration. There are upcoming appointments in the works for Mayo. Her variant of this syndrome has never been seen before and was the first entry under that variant. The future will involve many appointments and many follow-ups along with lifelong medication. There is no cure for this but we'll keep moving forward in hopes that she lives a full life the best way she can. Parents are Tyler and Sara Halter. A Go fund me account has also been set up to help this family with ongoing medical costs if you are able to help.
